Nonviolent Crisis Intervention - Refresher Program

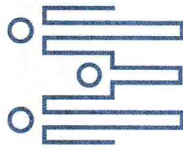

By participating in this year's Refresher program, you will have the opportunity to:

- Develop a greater understanding of course concepts
- Problem solve and strengthen crisis intervention skills
- Receive additional supporting information
- Demonstrate ability and confidence in applying course content and skills to real - life fostering experiences.
