What is Nonviolent Crisis Intervention Training?

This Introductory Level Training Program consists of crisis intervention techniques, both verbal and physical, that provide care, welfare, safety and security for everyone involved in a crisis situa-

tion. The goal of this program is to teach foster parents proactive strategies ~ to prevent a crisis from escalating ~ with an emphasis on communication skills.

BASIC PROGRAM

The Basic Program is for foster parents who have not taken NVCI before or whose NVCI certification has expired (more than 13 months since last certification) and they are required to repeat the Basic program. This introductory program consists of twelve hours of training over a 2 day period.
