



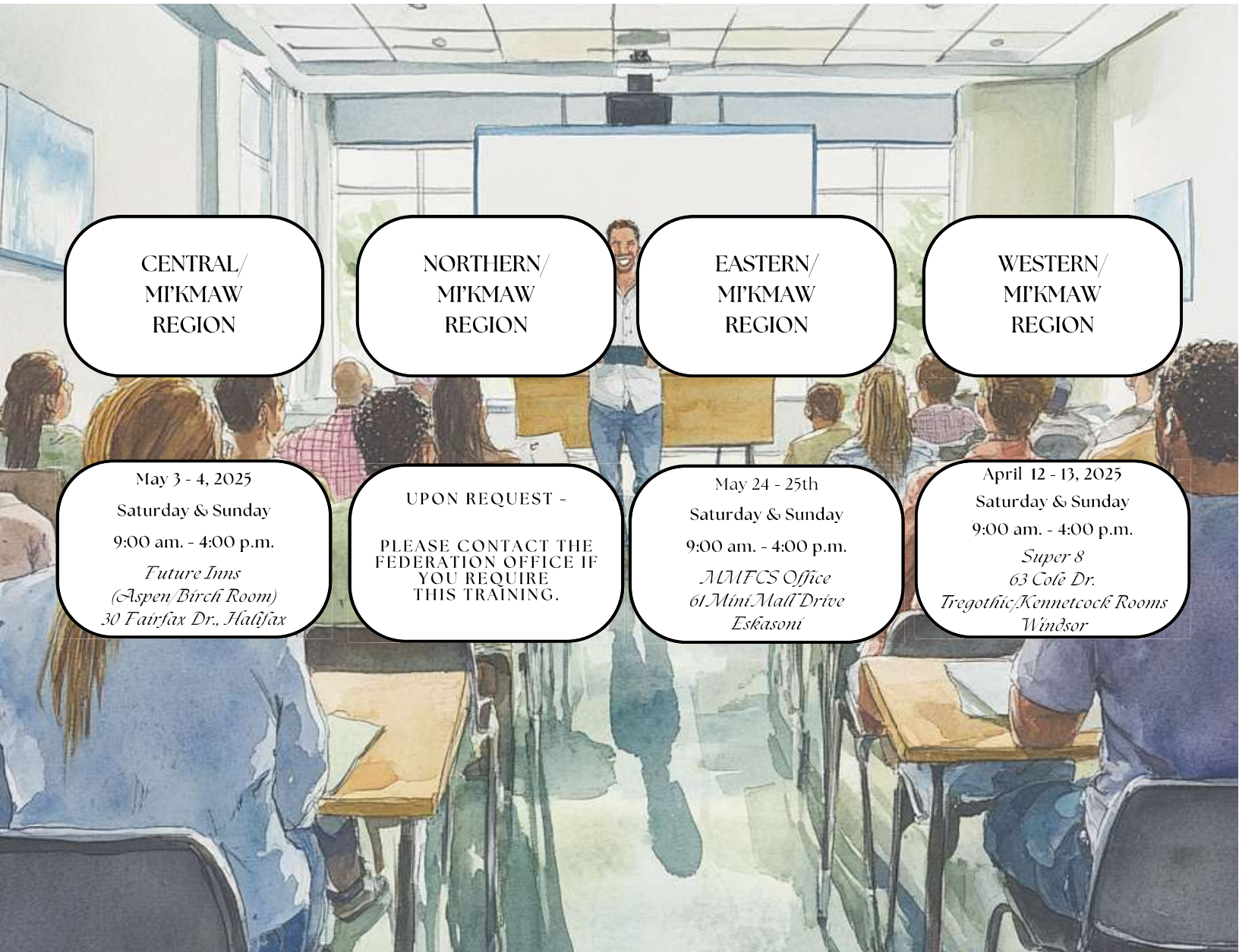
BASIC TRAINING - 2 DAYS

NON-VIOLENT CRISIS INTERVENTIONS SPRING 2025



This Introductory Level Training Program includes both verbal and physical crisis intervention techniques aimed at ensuring care, welfare, safety, and security for all individuals involved in a crisis. The primary objective of this program is to equip foster parents with proactive strategies to prevent crises from escalating, with a strong focus on enhancing communication skills.

This introductory course comprises twelve hours of training spread over a two-day period.
