What is Non-Violent Crisis Intervention Training?

This Introductory Level Training Program includes both verbal and physical crisis intervention techniques aimed at ensuring care, welfare, safety, and security for all individuals involved in a crisis. The primary objective of this program is to equip foster caregivers with proactive strategies to prevent crises from escalating, with a strong focus on enhancing communication skills.

This introductory course comprises twelve hours of training spread over a two-day period.
